

# Biographical or Historical Note

In 1958, the Roswell Business Men's Club held a centennial celebration in honor of Mittie Bulloch's wedding to Theodore Roosevelt in Roswell, Georgia. They were the parents of 18<sup>th</sup> President, Theodore Roosevelt. The event lasted three days and included a reenactment of Roosevelt's 1905 visit to Roswell during his Tour of the South as well as tours of Bulloch Hall.

This collection contains printed materials and records from the Theodore Roosevelt Centennial held in Roswell, Georgia in 1958. The records include correspondence, transcripts of speeches, organizational notes, and a list of loaned antiques used to furnish Bulloch Hall.
